alliteration Successive words that begin with the same letter or sound

example: Singing a song of sorrow

comparison establishing a relationship between two things

example: Roses are more beautiful than her

contrast used to show that two things are different

example: *life* **→** *death*

metaphor an image, a description of s.th./s.b. in an imaginative, unusual way to

compare two things an to show that they have qualities in common

example: She has a heart of stone; Life is a stage

personification giving non-living objects human traits

example: The storm slept for two days.

rhetorical a question that already implies the answer

question example: Do you think I'm stupid?

simile a comparison using words the words like/as

example: He had a face like a mask

symbol replacing/ expressing s.th. by using the word that represents a more

general quality

example: white = symbol of innocence, purity

rose= symbol of love
